Rules and Regulations

Purpose: Our goal is to provide students with an opportunity to showcase their work on a large screen in front of an audience. We hope that this will serve as further motivation for students within The Industry to create compelling visual stories.

Eligibility:

- 1. Each crew member of submitted work must be a student at the University of Georgia during the time period in which they worked on the entry. Faculty members may be involved only be as an advisor or actor.
- 2. Any music, graphics, or further content not created by the entry's crew must be used legally. Be sure to check which license you are using others' content under.
- 3. The student whose name the entry is submitted under must be a member of The Industry. To be a member of The Industry, sign up here:

- 4. Offensive, pornographic, or defamatory content will result in immediate disqualification of the entry. Judgement of the piece by the First Floor Film Fest committee is final.
- 5. Due to time constraints, not every entry will be viewed at First Floor Film Fest.
- 6. A nomination may be revoked by the First Floor Film Fest committee at any time and for to any reason.
- 7. The Spring 2019 First Floor Film Fest is free to enter.
- 8. Submitting to First Floor Film Fest indicates that student entering has read, understands and accepts these rules and regulations.



- 9. Entries submitted in any language other than English may not be understood or appropriately judged.
- The same piece recut to different lengths may not be entered in 10. both long form and short form categories.

Categories

Long Form: Videos at or longer than ten (10) minutes and shorter than thirty (30) minutes.

Short Form: Videos shorter than ten (10) minutes.



Judging and Awards

Official judges will be selected by the First Floor Film Fest committee. Selection of both nominees and winners by First Floor Film Fest committee and official judges will be based on *technical skill*, *creativity*, and *story*. Each category will be evaluated using a scale from 1-10 (with 10 being the best and 1 being the worst) for a possible total of 30 points.

Judge Vote:

Judges will choose one winner from both categories (long form and short form) based on which submission receives the most points.

Audience Vote:

Audiences will be sent a Google Form in which they will vote on their favorite long form and short form.

An entry IS permitted to win both a judge and audience vote.
